

WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

Any interested person, or his or her authorized representative, may submit written comments relative to the proposed amended emergency regulatory action.

Comments must satisfy the following requirements:

- Comments must be in writing, which includes email;
- Comments must identify the emergency regulation being addressed;
- Comments must be sent to the rulemaking agency's contact person for the emergency regulation; and
- Comments must be sent to OAL and received by OAL and the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board within five (5) calendar days of the filing of the emergency regulation with OAL.

Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law, the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency to the Office of Administrative Law, the Office of Administrative Law shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6.
